BLOOMINGTON'S GLBT FILM FESTIVAL

**JUST DAYS AWAY...**

*BLOOMINGTON, IN*— PRIDE, Bloomington's only annual film festival is just one week away! The PRIDE Film Festival is a cinematic celebration of the gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community hosted and presented by the historic Buskirk-Chumley Theater from January 26-29. Founded in 2004, the Festival was an immediate success. The second year brought nearly 1200 people and featured films from all over the world. This year the festival expands once again featuring more than twenty movies including shorts, animation, documentaries and full-length feature films. (See attached schedule for details)

In addition to movies, the festival promises a queer film panel discussion with the IU Department of Communication and Culture, a performance by Quarryland Men's Chorus, a high-voltage PRIDE Dance Party and other engaging events like an art reception for the exhibit *SEX IN THE CINEMA* at the Kinsey Institute, special PRIDE brunches and happy hours at local establishments. ### THE PRIZES

Due to the overwhelming response to past festivals, this year more screenings have been added. For the first time PRIDE: Bloomington's GLBT Film Festival will award prizes to talented filmmakers. Prizes include Audience Favorite, PRIDE: Jury Selection Award and the Alfred C. Kinsey Award- named in recognition of Alfred Kinsey's groundbreaking sexuality research. This award will become a prestigious and coveted award in the independent film industry, increasing visibility for both the Kinsey Institute at Indiana University and the annual Festival.

### THE PARTY

The PRIDE Dance Party will take over the entire theater generating a queer space where creativity, acceptance, vitality and the carnivalesque are available to everyone. The Party takes place on Friday evening after Screening #2. Admission to the party is included with the purchase of any Festival Pass. Move through the urban dance atmosphere, tapas bar area and dancefloor or visit the lobby for conversation and mingling. In the lobby area enjoy bright colored canopies filled with food from BLU Culinary Arts, Tina's Cuisine and Catering, Runcible Spoon/Bloomington Cooking School and Tutto Bene. Dance the night away in style with a DJ, drag queens and kings, professional dancers and enjoy a cash bar and delectable food. With over 400 party participants expected, the Pride Film Festival Party will be outrageous!
