BLOOMINGTON'S ONLY GLBT FILM FESTIVAL IS JUST A FEW WEEKS AWAY!

BLOOMINGTON, IN- PRIDE, Bloomington's only annual film festival is set for January 25-27, 2007. The PRIDE Film Festival is a cinematic celebration of the gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community hosted and presented by the historic Buskirk-Chumley Theater. Founded in 2004, the Festival was an immediate success and has continued to grow each year. Nearly 2000 people attended last year's festival which featured films from all over the world. This year the festival expands once again with more than thirty movies including shorts, documentaries and full-length feature films.

In addition to movies, the festival includes an art lecture and reception at the Kinsey Institute, a high-voltage PRIDE Dance Party and other entertaining events like special PRIDE brunches and happy hours at local establishments.

NEWLY ADDED EVENTS

This year's festival includes special screenings of films chosen by a panel of IU students and PRIDE volunteers. *Fat Girls* and *Queer Spawn* will be featured at the Indiana University Whittenberger Auditorium beginning at 8:00pm on Wednesday, January 24.

Over the course of the weekend, the Buskirk-Chumley will also host two directors' panel discussions where filmmakers will have the opportunity to discuss their projects and the filmmaking process. On Thursday, January 25 at 5:00pm join Susan Stryker, writer/director for *Screaming Queens* and Colin A. Weil, co-producer for *Rock Bottom*, as they discuss documentary filmmaking and the development of both these outstanding films.

The second panel is on Saturday, January 27 at 12:30pm and features writer/director/editor Ned Farr and producers Mike Carp and Drea Weber (for *The Gymnast*) and Indianapolis-based writer/director Catherine Crouch (for *Pretty Ladies* and *One Small Step*). Join our guests as they discuss their methods for writing and directing compelling films.

THE PARTY

The PRIDE Dance Party will take over the entire theater generating a queer space where creativity, acceptance, vitality and the carnivalesque are available to everyone. The Party takes place on Saturday night, after the last screening. Admission to the party is included with the purchase of a Saturday evening ticket or a Weekend Festival Pass. This year's party features aerialists from the widely acclaimed Bloomington High Flyers who defy gravity with an amazing display of acrobatics. Move through the urban dance atmosphere, tapas bar area and dance floor or visit the lobby for conversation and mingling. Complimentary appetizers and deserts will be available from BLU Culinary Arts, Bloomingfoods, Bloomington Cooking School and Tutto Bene. Dance the night away in style with DJ Sugarsnaps, drag queens and kings, professional dancers and enjoy a cash bar and delectable food. With over 400 party participants expected, the Pride Film Festival Party will be outrageous so dress to impress- costumes, masks and erotic attire encouraged!
